

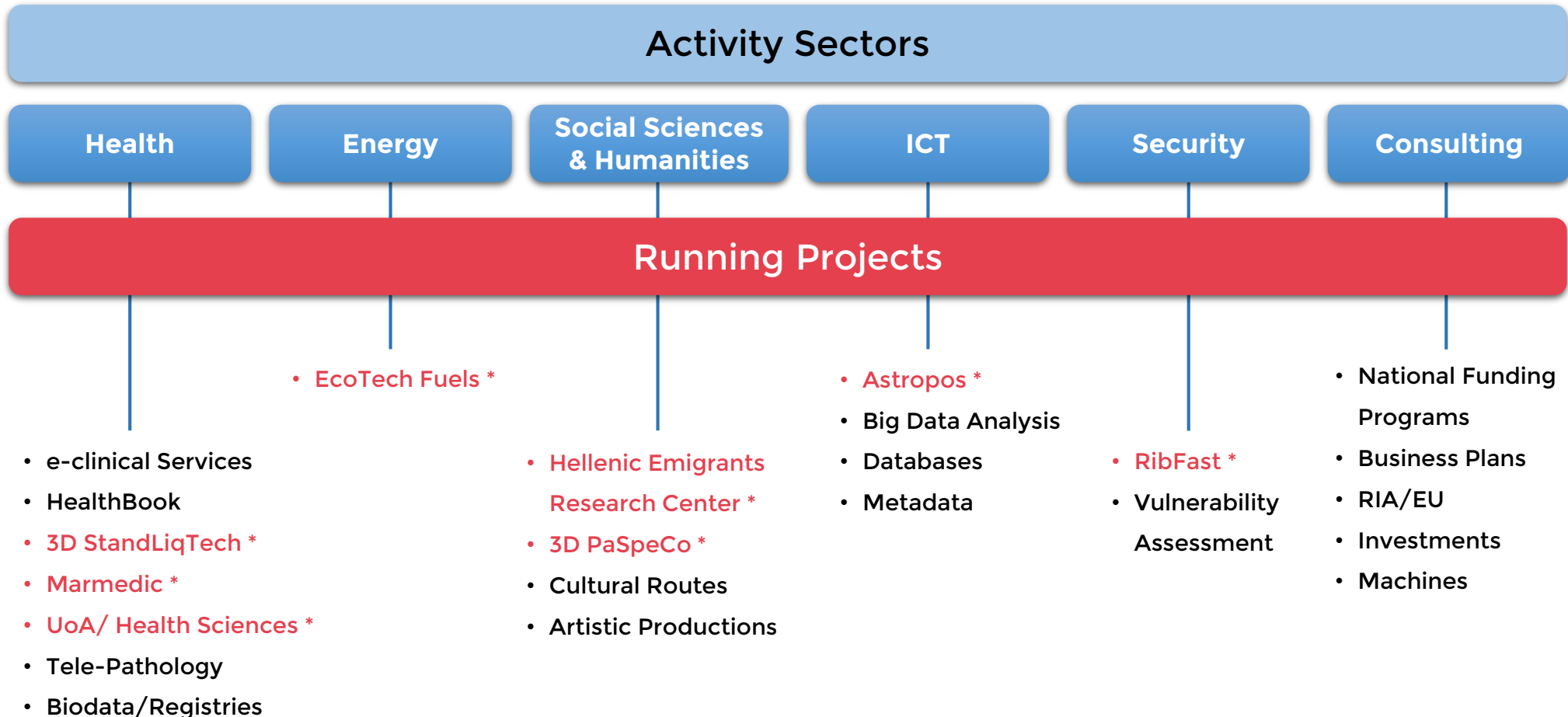

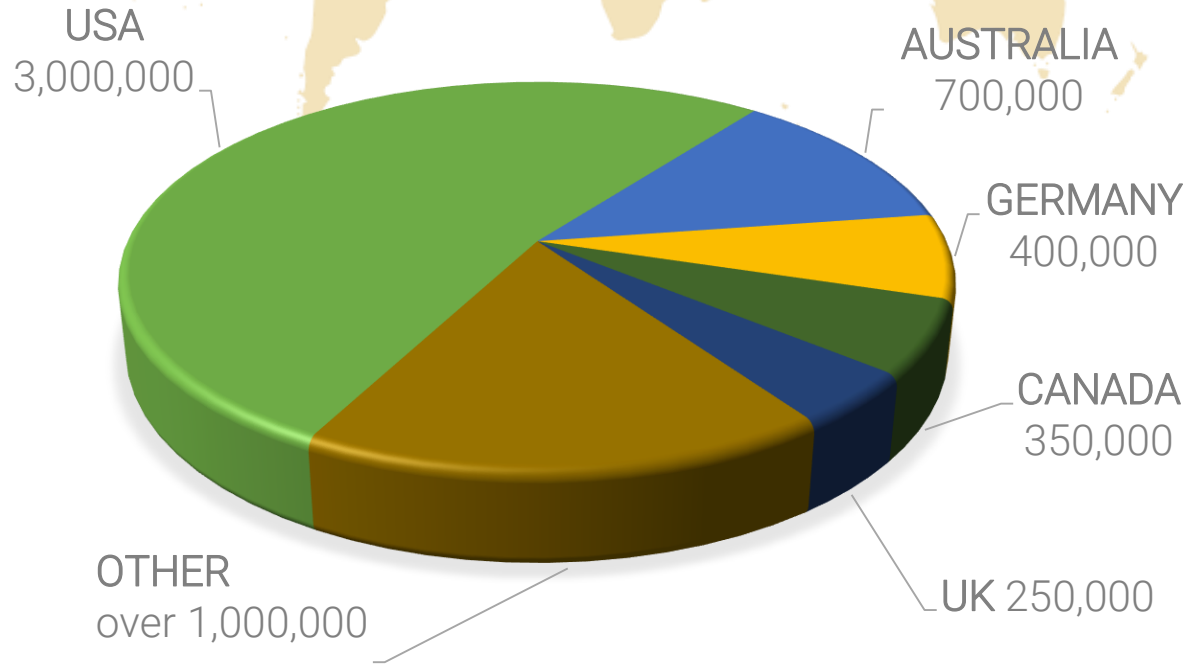

New employment created for scientists and researchers

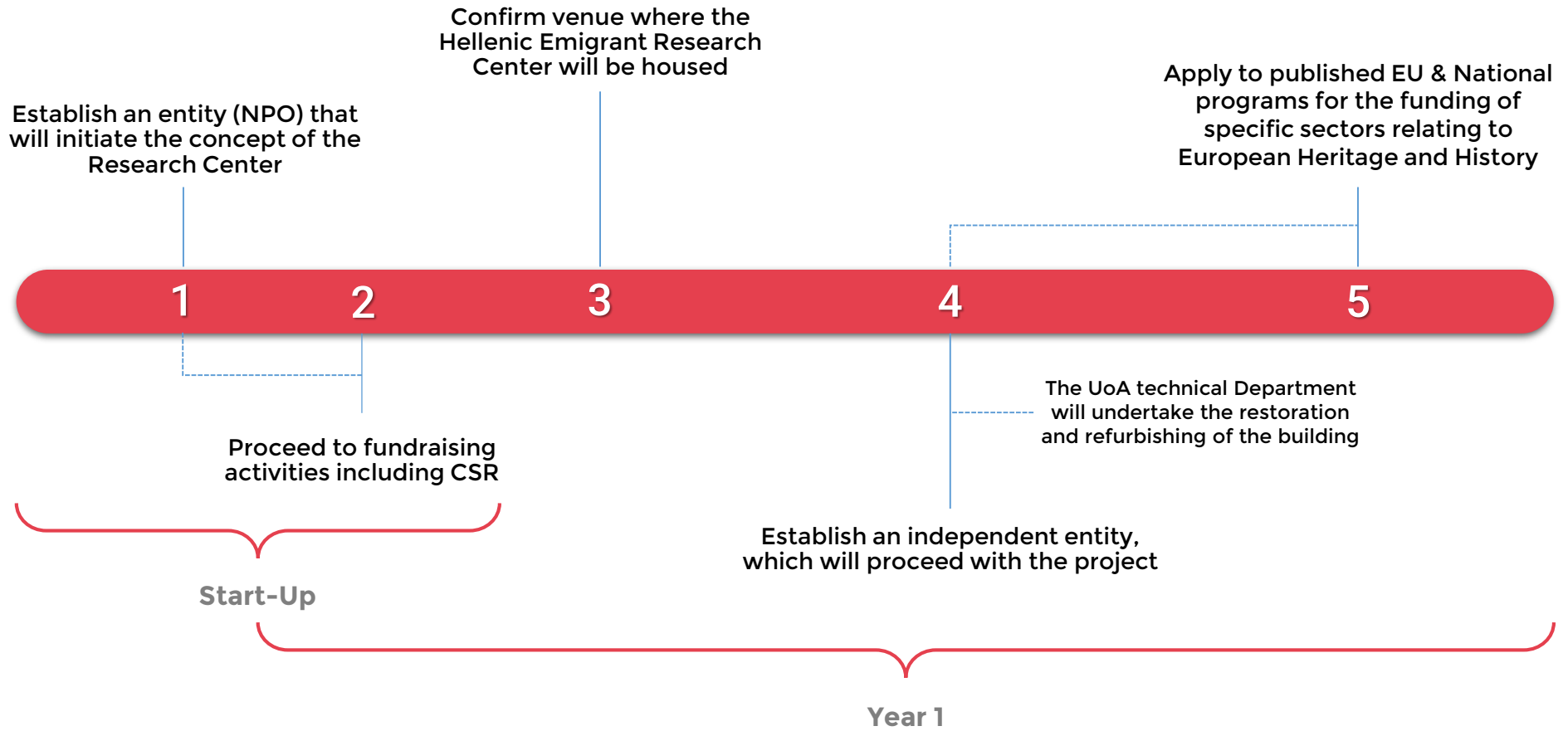
